

Silver Medal of Valor

For your courageous quick actions: while driving on Highway 280 at night, you saw a badly damaged Jeep resting on its roof and pulled over.

You checked on the Jeep's occupants and assessed that they were injured but able to exit the rear of the vehicle.

You observed a badly damaged BMW down an embankment, which was engulfed in flames and had flipped back onto its wheels settling in weeds three- to four-feet high.

An intense brush fire burned around the BMW concealing the whereabouts of the driver.

You heard the victim but had to travel through thick brush and around the fire to find her. When you finally located the victim, she was face up on the ground with multiple bloody injuries and paralyzed legs.

The fire burned quickly toward you and the victim while flames and smoke intensified and threatened to block your only exit.

You could not move the woman by yourself but were able to direct others to assist you, immobilizing the victim's head with your jacket and moving her to safety.

You stayed at the scene to assist, placing flares around the accident, briefing first responders and directing traffic.

Your heroic response prevented a severely injured woman from burning to death.

With no first responders on the scene, you got your Boogie Board and fins and swam with another bystander to the female victim who could not swim to shore due to the undertow. You succeeded in saving her, but her husband could not be found.

For your heroic actions while traveling on Highway 80: while following a truck that hit multiple vehicles between Highways 50 and 80 until the vehicle was disabled. A CHP Officer arrived on the scene. The suspect got out of his truck, punched the officer and continued punching and stomping her while she was on the ground. You stopped your vehicle, engaged the suspect, hitting him so hard he landed on the ground and then wrestled with him to keep him down. A bystander joined you and kept the suspect down until other CHP Officers arrived.
